### Changes to the Preaching Plan

Just a couple of changes to note from the printed plan

Christmas Day - We will be joining the congregation at Ainsdale Methodist Church at 10.30, there will be no service at Liverpool Road (there is an 11.30pm service of Holy Communion on Christmas Eve at Liverpool Road).

Sunday 29th January - This will be led by Rev Patrick Evans when we will be joined by the congregations of St James, St John's and St Peters Anglican Churches.



A few weeks ago we shared details of a Methodist Way of Life on this page. In January, February and March, at our Circuit Evening Services (second Sunday of the Month at 6.30pm at Liverpool Road Methodist Church), we will be exploring a Methodist Way of Life.

**January 8th - What is a Methodist?** - Introducing the foundations of the Methodist Church using the themes found within 'Our Calling'.

**February 12th - Daily Walk with God** - This act of worship explores how, as disciples, we notice, hear and respond to God in our daily lives.

March 12th - A Rhythm of Life - This act of worship seeks to introduce A Methodist Way of Life within an intergenerational context, focusing on the sense of rhythm that a way or rule of life can create for an individual or household.

Each month there will be the opportunity to join a study group to find out more about a Methodist Way of Life. Each group will last for 90 minutes. You can join a group even if you have not been able to make it to the evening service. You will shortly be receiving "A Brief Guide to a Methodist Way of Life" which introduces a Methodist Way of Life and suggests different ways you may choose to engage with it, and a study guide titled "Finding the Way - Getting started with A Methodist Way of Life". Timings of the study groups will be announced in due course. We do hope that you will be able to join us.
