Dear Friends

The Methodist Church has to ensure the data it holds on you is stored and managed in line with statutory requirements. The Methodist Church provides guidelines for the storage of data ([Guidance for Managing Trustees on Data Protection](#)). Local churches, Circuits and Districts find themselves holding a variety of personal data, and this guidance helps us to identify what personal data is, how to hold it securely and for what purposes it can be used, such as Circuit and District directories for office holders within the Church.

The Southport Circuit is responsible for ensuring information held within the Circuit is compliant. To achieve this we will be using a market leading online data base called [Churchsuite](#), rather than using ad hoc methods such as spreadsheets etc. Churchsuite allows us to maintain, in one place, contact details including names, addresses, phone numbers and email.

We will only hold data needed for contact purposes, although for office holders we may record some further information relating to your role (e.g. training completed, DBS renewal date). Officers of the church can access the data appropriate to their role. You will be able to access your data, check that it is correct and specify what contact details, if any, you want to be shared with other people in the church.

If we have your email address you will shortly be sent a link via email so you can review your details. If you don't have an email address you will receive a letter with a return form to confirm your details. Doreen Iddon, Pastoral Visitors Secretary, can amend your details if you don't have an email account, or if you prefer not to update the records yourself.

You can also download Churchsuite as an App to your phone. Over the coming months we will be adding a calendar of our local events.

Martin Maynard looks after the Churchsuite and is available to offer support. Martin will be on hand after the service on Sunday 5th February to answer any questions and assist with any issues relating to your data.
