

### **Dear Friends**



Across the year the Trust meet with 70% of primary and 100% of secondary school pupils (totalling 6400 children). This is through leading assemblies, running workshops, holding school yard drop-ins, after-school clubs and much much more. In an age of ever-increasing need, with escalating mental health and wellbeing concerns, there is a demand to expand their work locally. Schools are constantly requesting more than the Trust can deliver. The Trust feel a burden to expand and meet the local needs on behalf of, and in partnership with churches and Christians across the town. To fully meet this demand the Trust have calculated they would need an annual income of £135,000 to fully seize the demand of schools and bring Christian hope to young people in our community.

For us as Methodists, the invitation from the Trust is to support and partner with them as a Circuit, local churches and/or individuals. Support at a Circuit level will be considered at the June Circuit Meeting following consultation between the Circuit Leadership Team and the Trust. In the meantime local churches and individuals can support the Trust directly. To find out more about what the Trust do, please see the SASWT booklet attached to this email.
