Dear Friends

On Tuesdays the Wesley Guild meet and for Lent Colin Fyles is leading them through a course on Evangelism. You don't have to be part of the Guild to attend, anyone can come along on Tuesday's at 7.30pm in the New Room. Last Tuesday was an introduction and this week they start the "Talking of God with Others" series, so it's certainly not too late to join. Just come along to those sessions that you can make.

The series helps us to share our faith with people who have little or no faith and have questions about Christianity. It will:

- equip us to respond more knowledgeably when people ask about our faith
- grow our skills and confidence so we can answer challenging questions that help people understand what it means to know Jesus Christ
- enable us to discuss and clarify Christianity with people of little or no faith.

This structured series is for use in groups or as individuals, so if you cannot attend in person, or cannot attend each week, you can follow the material by yourself. The series follow the themes of:

- Christian belief
 - God
 - Jesus
 - Suffering
 - Church
 - Faith.

These are the topics most likely to come up in conversations about Christian faith with those who are not Christian. Each session includes

worship,

- real-life stories with practical insights from Christians who talked with others about their faith
- a story from the Gospels illustrating how Jesus engaged in conversation with people
 - questions and Bible verses to discuss
 - prayers, reflections and follow-up questions
 - further resources to explore issues in more depth.
