The next Birkdale Churches Prayer meeting will be held on Monday 5th June at the station masters house in Birkdale Village starting at 10am.


Good Pantry



Dear Friends



I imagine we don't consider ourselves to have any superpower. Jesus on the other-hand, we can definitely see that he had superpowers and we would consider him to be our Superhero...in-fact the Superhero above all Superheroes. He performed many miracles and rose from the dead. Importantly he isn't a fictional character for he is real. So where did his superpower come from?

"As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him." (Matthew Ch 3 vs 16)

"The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me."

(Luke Ch 4 vs 17)

This Sunday is Pentecost which comes from the Greek word pentekoste which means fiftieth, and is celebrated fifty days after Easter. It is when we recall how God's Holy Spirit was given to the disciples after Jesus' ascension, empowering them to begin the work of making disciples of all nations. The gift of the Holy Spirit to the disciples doesn't stop just there, it continues to be poured out today upon us.

Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. (1 Corinthians Ch 12 vs 7)

So what gift do you have that God uses for the common good? If you continue to read-on in 1 Corinthians Ch 12 from verse 8 it lists the gifts of the Spirit as word of wisdom, word of knowledge, faith, gifts of healing, miracles, prophecy, distinguishing between spirits, tongues, interpretation of tongues. Later in the chapter from verse 28 it lists the roles and gifts of apostle, prophet, teacher, miracles, healer, helper, administration and tongues. Romans Ch 12 lists prophecy, serving, teaching, exhortation, giving, leadership and mercy.

So, what is your superpower?
